Musical Theatre Bootcamp #1 and #2: (ages 7 and up)

**6-year-olds may be considered based on experience and/or training*

Love to sing? Love to act? Love to dance? If so, this two-week session is the program for you! Learn what it takes to be a musical theatre performer. Participants will partake in daily physical and vocal warm-ups before being coached in acting, singing, and dance to prepare for the program-culminating musical production! Participants will have the opportunity to work with:

- *Directors – who will teach them essential skills including line delivery, pacing, and voice projection.
- * Musical Directors/ pianist – who will teach singing, breathing, rhythm, pitch, and tone.
- * Choreographer – who will teach how to move onstage, dance steps, and floor patterns.

These dynamic instructors will teach essential life skills such as: public speaking, responsibility, commitment, confidence, and teamwork. There will also be opportunities for participants interested in backstage theatre roles. Interested participants will learn about, and have the opportunity to participate in, behind-the-scenes tasks such as: hair, make-up, stage management, set design/construction, costuming, lighting, and sound. This is the perfect session for anyone aspiring to one day join an Oshawa Little Theatre production/ Youth Group!

Triple Threat Toolbox: (ages 7 and up)

**6-year-olds may be considered based on experience and/or training*

Build your actor's 'toolbox' through this intensive! Learn everything you need to know about being a performer! With a variety of workshops throughout the weeks, participants will receive instruction in the actor's voice, stage movement, physical theatre, character development, scene study, improv, and production. In addition, instruction in the "art of auditioning" will allow participants to experience the process of auditioning for a full-scale production and help them develop the necessary skills and confidence to do so. Throughout the session, each participant will select appropriate audition pieces, complete an actor's resume, and have his/her head-shot taken. These 'tools of the trade' will help build confidence, develop skills in communication, support the use of imagination, and stretch creativity! Working with fellow actors, learn to bring life to the text and to characters. A final workshop performance will give you the opportunity to prove you have all the necessary tools to fill your toolbox to the brim!
